Your doctor may have requested an exam that requires the injection of contrast called gadolinium. This material will help diagnose a problem but will not cure your condition. Gadolinium has been used safely in millions of cases; however minor reactions (headache or nausea) occur in about 2% of patients. More serious life threatening reactions are even rarer.

CT PATIENTS ONLY

Your doctor may have requested an exam that requires the injection of contrast. The contrast is administered intravenously and is eliminated by your kidneys. The contrast will help diagnose a problem but will not cure your condition. Complications from the contrast are rare but can include, and are not limited to: nausea, hives, vomiting or rash. In some extremely rare cases, kidney failure or even death may occur.
